Julia MacLaine (of the NACO) weaves baroque, folk, and newly-commissioned Canadian works in a celebration of the rich tradition of music for solo cello.



Steve Boudreau is an Ottawa-based pianist who specializes in jazz and popular music. He has taught private lessons for over twenty years. He holds a Master of Music degree in jazz performance from the New England Conservatory in Boston. His recording output includes six solo piano albums, a trio album featuring unique arrangements of the music of George Gershwin, and a quartet album of original music co-led by guitarist Garry Elliott. A new album of original music for trio is scheduled for release later this year.

Garry Elliott has been a full-time freelance professional guitarist since 1980. He performs regularly with the city's finest players. He has collaborated with Steve Boudreau on two CDs featuring their original compositions, *Pre-Dawn Skies* and *Opus 2*, and with classical flutist Gertrude Létourneau on the CD *Habañera*. He teaches classical and jazz guitar at Carleton University as well as privately.
