Michael Curtis Hanna loves to sing! The oldest son of the late Detroit-born pianist and composer Sir Roland Hanna, Michael was nurtured through a unique musical life. Having an acute fondness for male vocal harmony, he sang with many choirs including Ted Thomas' Sound Virtue, the Hartford Memorial Baptist Church Men's Chorus, and the Canadian Men's Chorus of Toronto. Michael currently manages the publishing company Rahanna Music and record label RMI, developed by Roland and Ramona Hanna.

Edward Lister is a UK-born trumpeter, composer, and educator. With a 2:1 BA Hons degree in jazz performance and composition studies from Leeds College of Music (UK), he has been based out of Ottawa since 2011 and currently runs seven of his own ensembles including his eleven-piece Prime Rib Big Band. Edward owns and operates the entertainment agency London Gentleman Records which represents and works with local Ottawa talent. Edward has toured the globe and shared the stage with some of the best.

Guitarist **Alex Moxon** has been a familiar face on the Ottawa jazz scene for more than a decade. An up-and-comer on the world jazz stage, the Ottawa-raised musician's debut record as a leader, *Alex Moxon Quartet*, has received international radio airplay and stellar reviews. On Moxon's first record, Peter Hum of the *Ottawa Citizen* says "[Moxon] blends shards of the blues, modal motifs and flashes of guitar wizardry."

Bassist **JP Lapensee** specializes in jazz, jazz fusion, Cuban and Brazilian music. JP plays across Canada and abroad. When not on tour, he can be seen performing in the Ottawa-Gatineau, Montreal and Toronto areas with several groups such as the Prime Rib Big Band, The Chocolate Hot Pockets, Fiesta Cubana, Modasaurus, and The HML Trio.

Jamie Holmes has been a active in the Ottawa music scene for the past 7 years. With over 15 years of experience behind the kit, Jamie plays in styles ranging from jazz, Latin and funk to rock, pop and hip-hop. Jamie, a graduate of music performance at Carleton University, can be heard with his jazz group The HML Trio, and his funky hip-hop fusion power quartet The Chocolate Hot Pockets. Jamie also works in the studio as a session player, on musical productions, on cruise ships, composing his own music and teaching.
