Peter Woods (saxophone) and **Tom Reynolds** (piano) shine hope and wisdom through the lens of Canadian poet, philosopher, and musician Jan Zwicky.

Tomoko Inui came to Montreal from Alaska to study with Professor Kyoko Hashimoto at McGill University. In 2004, she was given the Bruneau Prize from McGill for her exceptional solo recital. She is an affiliated professor at le Conservatoire de musique de Montréal and has given concerts through the 'Maisons de la culture' program in Montreal. She is an avid chamber musician, having performed with the Alexander String Quartet, cellists Laurentieu Sbarcea and Valentin Scharff, and violist Marcus Thompson.



A native of Taiwan, violinist **Jung Tsai** has won several competitions and prizes including the Mannes Community Orchestra Solo Competition, Honourable Mention in the Plowman Chamber Music Competition, and the Luminarts Fellowship in 2015. In addition to solo performance, she is currently serving as Second Associate Concertmaster of the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony. Other orchestral experiences include serving as Assistant Concertmaster of the Civic Orchestra in Chicago and a member of the Kalamazoo Symphony.



Cellist **Rebecca Morton** inspires audiences with her honesty, ease, and love of music making. She is currently Associate Principal cellist of the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony. She has played with the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra, Toronto Symphony Orchestra, and the Niagara Symphony, among others. A gifted soloist and ensemble member, she was a longtime member of the Kamareli String Quartet and has been heard in many solo and chamber music recitals, most recently with members of the Canadian Opera Company.
