He has performed at ChamberFest, JazzFest, FolkFest, TulipFest and sold out concerts at venues such as Irene's Pub and Pressed. Duhaime is the recipient of the 2018 RBC Emerging Artist Award from the Ottawa Arts Council, the first musician to ever receive the award. As a freelance guitarist Duhaime has performed in a wide array of musical styles. Most recently, he has emerged as a leading figure in the jazz manouche scene in Ottawa.
