Anna Baksheeva is a Canadian violinist and violin teacher based in Ottawa. She began studying violin in Russia at the age of 5, and now holds a bachelor's degree in violin performance from the University of Georgia (USA) and a master's from the University of Ot-



tawa. Anna enjoys the full spectrum of her work as a violin teacher and as a freelance violinist, collaborating with many fine musicians in the National Capital Region. She teaches at her home studio and performs music at retirement homes and for weddings, funerals, and other occasions. With her Duo Pleiades as well as other collaborators, Anna enjoys regular performances around Ottawa and Gatineau, and she is also part of a trio with Katherine Addlemann and Sophie Bertrand specializing in music by female composers. Anna lives in Ottawa and together with her musical husband they are raising two musical children.

Natalia Bibik-Chabukiani was born into a musical family in Kharkiv, Ukraine. Beginning playing piano at the age of five, she obtained a degree in piano solo performance from the St. Petersburg State Conservatory of N. Rimsky-Korsakov, and continued her music education at The Academy of Music in Tel Aviv and The Royal Conservatory of Music, Toronto (now the Glenn Gould School of Music). Natalia and her husband, Shalva Chabukiani, are founders of and were active players in the Concertino Regina Music Ensemble. Since moving to Ottawa in 2018,



Natalia has been playing chamber music all over Ottawa and Toronto, with a variety of musicians and groups including with "Trio Vaniata" and the NAC Orchestra.
