Soprano **Carmen Harris** and pianist **Matthew Larkin** evoke times of transition with works from popular and classical traditions.

Catherine Gendron is currently finishing her BMus at Carleton University. She performs in several groups including big bands, saxophone quartets, and small jazz groups. Catherine plays alto, soprano and tenor saxophones as well as doubling on flute and clarinet. She is known for her fabulous warm



sound, killer reading ability, and wonderful improvisational skills.



A veteran of the Ottawa music scene for more than 35 years, **Mike Tremblay** continues to perform regularly with ensembles including the NAC Orchestra and Prime Rib Big Band. Mike has released several recordings, including *Appleface*. Mike is an Associate Performance Faculty member at Carleton University where he teaches saxophone, the saxophone ensemble, a jazz improv course, and is the founder and artistic director of their annual Jazz Camp.

Petr Cancura did his BMus at Carleton University, then his master's at the New England Conservatory in Boston. He moved to New York City for ten years, cultivating professional relationships and establishing himself as a leader in the field of creative music. Now based in Ottawa, he is the director of the Ottawa Jazz Festival and teaches saxophone and ensembles at Carleton. Petr can be heard on many recordings including recent release *Don't Let It Stop!*



Richard Page is an Ottawa based woodwind specialist who is a much in



demand leader, sideman and educator in the Ottawa area. His performance and recording credits include Jerry Granelli, Robben Ford, Marc Copeland, and Bob Brookmeyer. Richard's woodwinds have been featured on television commercials, TV shows, movies including the children's cartoon *Esme & Roy*.
