The Primary Colours jazz trio (**Deniz Lim-Sersan**, piano; **Chris Pond**, bass; **José Hernandez García**, drums) plays a selection of classic and original ballads for the fall.

**Ralitsa Tcholakova** is an internationally renowned, award-winning Canadian violinist and violist. Ralitsa has performed as a soloist with orchestras at chamber music series and festivals in over 25 countries. She was



nominated for the Premier's Award for Excellence in the Arts in 2018. In 2017, she was nominated for the Governor General Persons Case Award. Ralitsa has recorded many highly acclaimed albums, including *Ballad of the North*, an album featuring music by female Canadian composers and distributed by SOCAN to

135 radio stations worldwide. Her CD *Aboriginal Inspirations* features multiple-Grammy-winner Ron Korb and is promoted nationally and internationally by the Canadian Music Centre and NAXOS. Ralitsa has performed numerous times as a soloist on both violin and viola at Carnegie Hall, where her next performance is November 26 under the baton of David Wroe with Orchestra Manhattan.

**Joycelin Mosey** is a pianist dedicated to bringing music to all spaces and ages. She is a founder of the National Christian Youth Summit and a former Parliamentary legislative assistant. During her time on the Hill, Joycelin enjoyed sharing music with diverse audiences. Collaborations include performances for the National Prayer Breakfasts and *A Saviour is Born*, an original filmed for the Christian Embassy. Other highlights include performances at the Glenn Gould Studio (Toronto) for Imago Arts Canada and the Lausanne Movement (Wisconsin), as well as Carnegie Hall (New York) and Bolshoi Theatre (Moscow) while a member of the Vancouver Children's Choir and Youth Symphony Orchestra. Joycelin holds a B.Mus. with a major in psychology from the University of British Columbia. Her piano teachers include Linda Shirley, Ailsa Zaenker, Henri-Paul Sicsic, Jane Coop and Robert Silverman. She has twice served as an artist-in-residence at the Banff Centre.

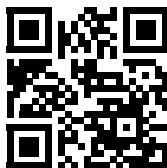
