Baritone **Luc Lalonde** and pianist **Fabien Tousignant** interpret songs and song cycles on travel and the passage of time by Vaughan Williams, Thompson, Holst, and Mana-Zucca.

Montreal-based **Steve Amirault** is an award-winning pianist, organist, vocalist, and composer who has significantly shaped the Canadian jazz scene. Raised in Les Buttes Amirault, Nova Scotia, in a musical family, Steve's journey began at home, influenced by his father, a pianist and organist. After studying jazz at St. Francis Xavier University, Amirault moved to Montreal and began his career as a sought-after jazz pianist and composer. He later lived and performed in New York City and Toronto, collaborating with jazz greats like Joe Lovano, Dave Liebman, Eddie Gomez, and Sheila Jordan.

Renowned for his technical brilliance and emotional depth, Amirault's style blends modern jazz, classical, and pop influences. He has received numerous accolades, including the ECMA and Prix Opus for Jazz Recording of the Year, the Montreal International Jazz Festival Competition, and three Juno Awards.

Steve began singing later in his career, adding his soulful baritone voice to his performances and recordings. For this presentation, he will perform a selection of his original songs that are sure to captivate the listener.
